ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND

LUMO Conservancy is an acronym for Lualenyi, Mramba, and Oza. It is a pioneer community-owned and managed conservancy located in Taita Taveta County. Established in the late 1990s, it was formed when three ranches merged to create a significant conservation area and explore wildlife-based ventures.

As a vital wildlife migratory corridor between Tsavo West National Park (Kenya) and Mkomanzi National Park (Tanzania), LUMO Conservancy hosts iconic wildlife and provides exceptional viewing opportunities for tourists.

OBJECTIVE OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

LUMO Conservancy seeks an eligible individual or firm to undertake the following:

1. Renovation and/or replacement of old signages to enhance visibility and navigation.
2. Boundary clearing to establish clear, accessible roads along the conservancy's perimeter for effective management and conservation purposes.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

1. **Signage Renovation/Replacement**
 - Renovation and/or replacement of existing conservancy signages, including entrance gates, tourism circuits, and zone boundaries.
 - Painting and inscription of clear, durable, and weather-resistant texts and images on the signages as per provided design below.



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GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Interested bidders should submit quotations and the following:

1. Proof of similar works carried out within the last three years, including references and contact details of previous clients.
2. Experience working in Taita Taveta County, particularly with conservancies, is preferred.
3. Proposals should remain valid for 14 calendar days after submission.
4. Quotation to be provided in Kenyan Shillings, including applicable taxes and charges.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The request for quotes (RFQ) does not constitute an offer by LUMO Conservancy.
2. Responses must be received by the specified deadline; late submissions will not be considered.
3. Quotes will be binding for the validity period stated by the bidder.
